Our standardized Bowens mount design offers you a variety of lighting control requirements, easily operated and highly versatile.

Instructions

- Please read and follow these instructions and keep well this manual for further use.
- Please unlock the protection cover and peel off the protection label before using.
- Please do not block the ventilation grille or touch the COB light directly, and do not face the light directly when the light is on.
- Do not place the LED light device near liquids, alcohol or other flammable objects to avoid damage.
- Keep the device out of reach of children.
- Only use a microfiber and dry cloth to clean the product.
- To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not use the product near water.
- Please have the product checked by an authorized service or agent if your product has a problem. The malfunctions caused by your no allowed disassembling are not under the warranty.

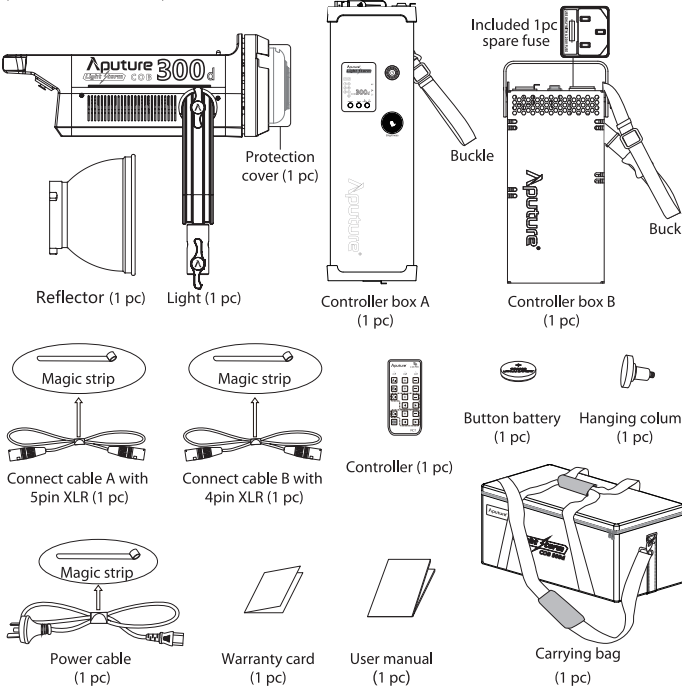
- Reorient or relocate the receiving antenna.

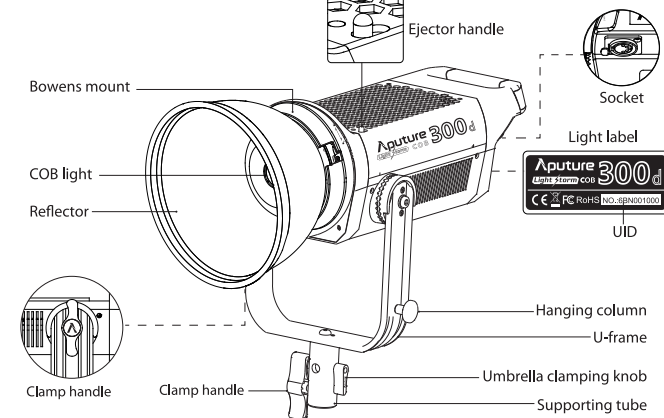

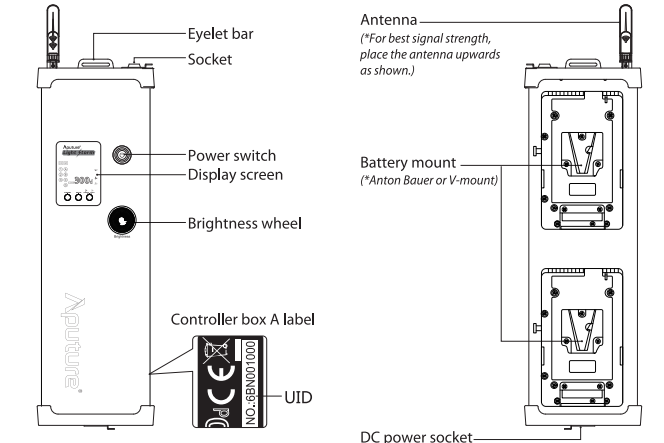

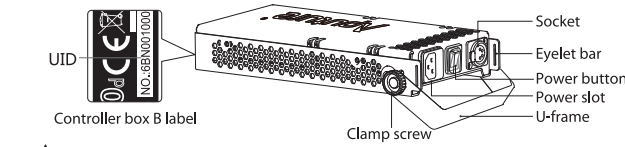


2. Controller box A



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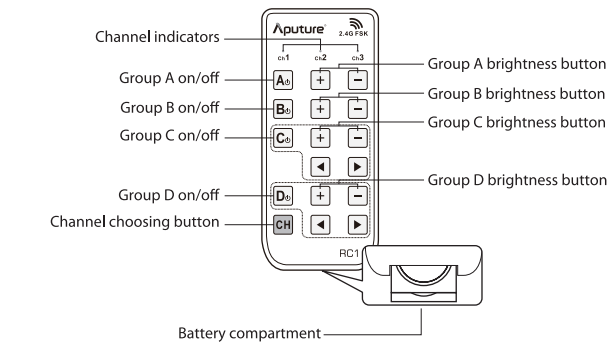
3. Controller box B



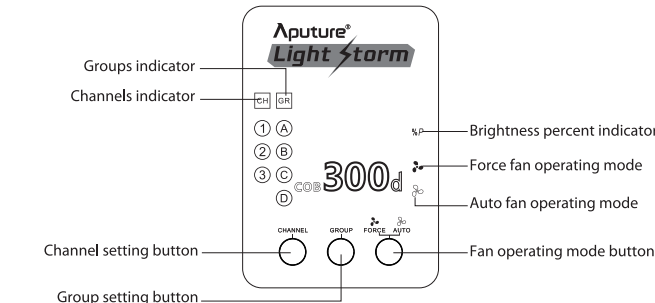

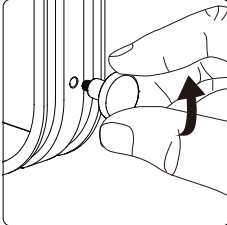

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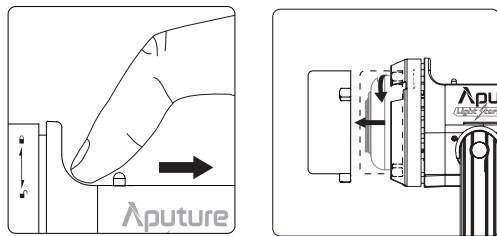
Installations

1. Install the hanging column



2. Protection cover unlock and install

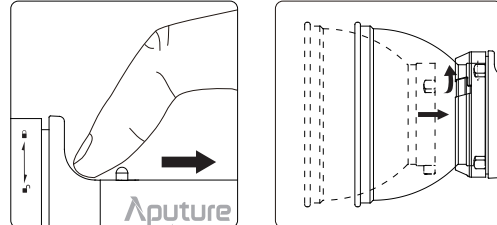
Pull ejector handle back, and unlock protection cover as the picture shows. Install protection cover rotate in the opposite direction.



* Please make sure you remove the protection cover before turning on the light to prevent melting or fire. Put the cover back on the light after each use.

3. Reflector install and unlock

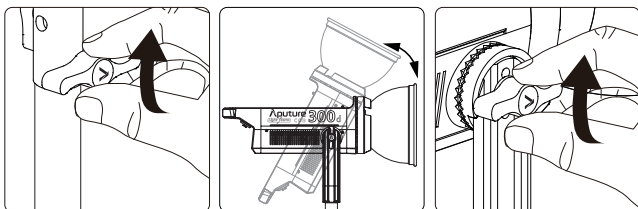
Pull ejector handle back, and install reflector as the picture shows. Unlock reflector rotate in the opposite direction.



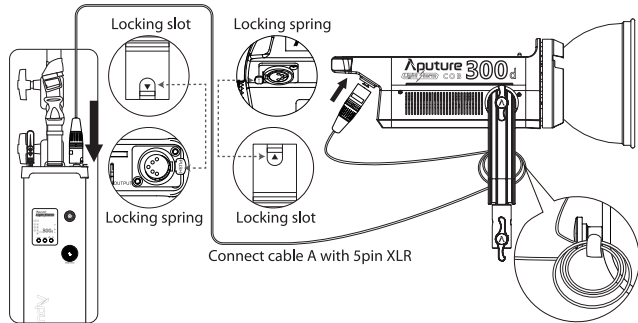
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4. Install the light

Set the light at your desired angle, then use the clamp handle to install the light onto stand and fasten.



5. Use connecting cable A connect light to controller box A



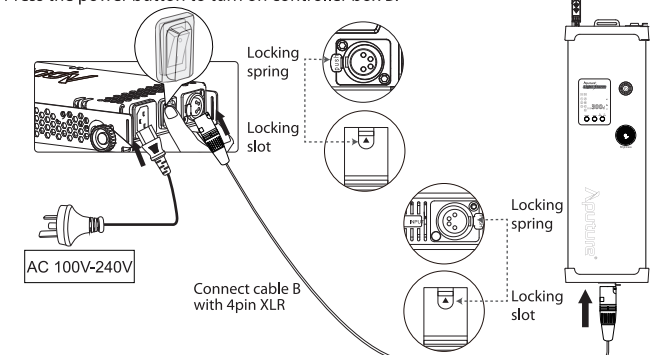
* Hang the controller box on the tripod by buckle.

* Please pull the connect cable out by pushing the locking spring down on the light and controller box A.

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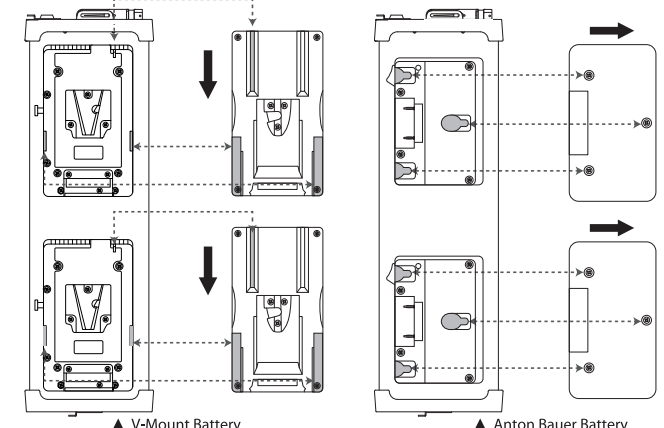
6. Dual power supply

1) Powered by the **adapter**
Connect cable B to link controller box A and B.
Press the power button to turn on controller box B.



* Please pull the connect cable out by pushing the locking spring down on the controller box A and controller box B.

2) Powered by **2pcs batteries**

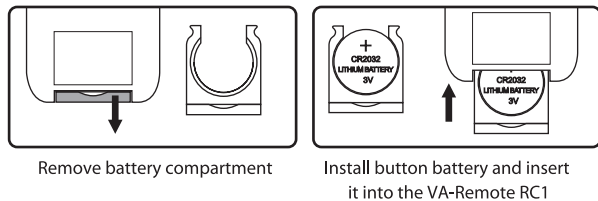


* Please make sure you purchase the correct battery based on V-Mount or Gold Mount.

* Please use the output current 12A, capacity more than 190WH of the battery.

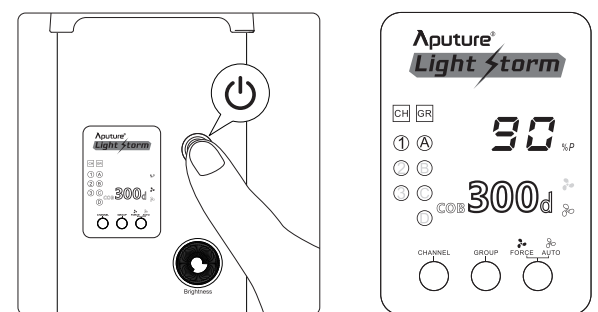
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7. Insert the button battery to power VA-Remote RC1



Operations

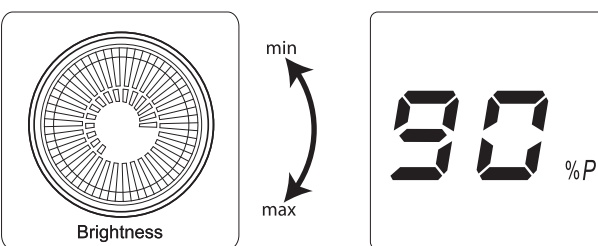
1. Press power switch to turn on the Light



* "Channel 1, Group A" is by default.

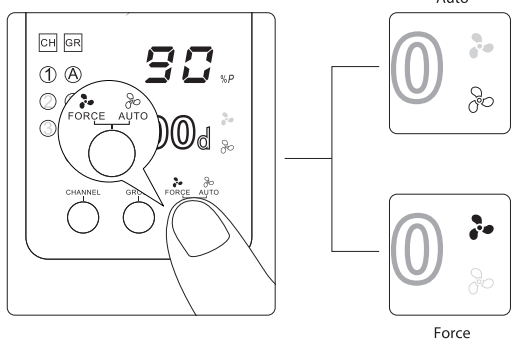
2. Manual controlled by the controller box

1) Brightness adjustment and display



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2) Press the (Auto/Force) button can adjust the fan operating model based on using environments, as the following picture shows



* 1) Auto Mode: Fan speed is automatically adjusted according to internal temperature. ("Auto mode" is by default)

* 2) Force Mode: Fan operates at maximum speed. (Recommended for high temperature shoots)

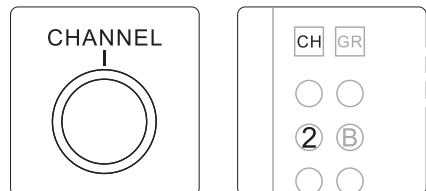
3. Remote control operations

* The Light Storm has three channels (1/2/3) and four groups (A- B- C- D).

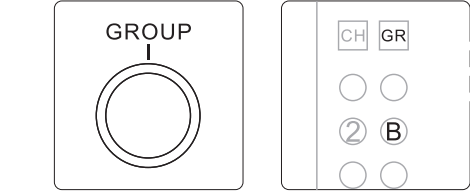
1) The controller box setting

*1) Channel setting and display

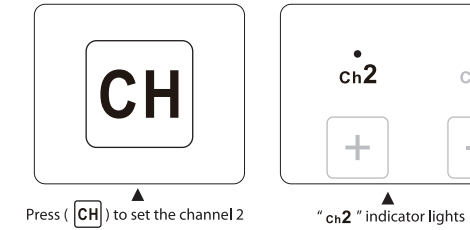


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*2) Group setting and display



2) The controller setting and display



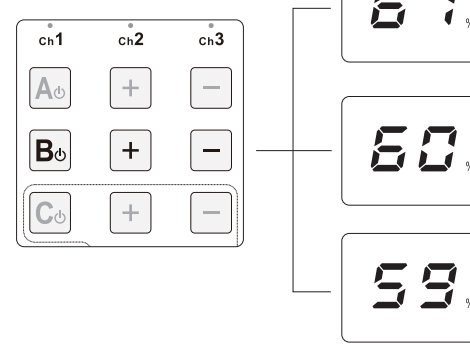
Press (CH) to set the channel 2

3) Brightness and color temperature adjustment

Press (B) of group B to adjust the brightness, the brightness varies 1%. Brightness changes between (10%-100%).
