


# Unpacking Instructions

Ple a se consider that damages caused by manual modifications to the device are not subject to warranty.

This device contains no use r-service able parts. Refer servicing to qualified technicians only.



#### IMPORIANT:

The manufacturer will not accept liability for any resulting damages caused by the non-observance of this manual or any unauthorized modification to the device.

- Neverlet the powercord come into contact with other cables! Handle the powercord and all connections with the mains with particular caution!
- Never remove waming or informative labels from the unit.
- Neveruse anything to cover the ground contact.
- Never run the device without lamp!
- Neverleave any cables lying around.
- Never look directly into the light source.
- Never use the device during thunders to ms. Unplug the device immediately.
- Do not insert objects into air vents.
- Do not open the device and do not modify the device.
- Do not connect this device to a dimmerpack.
- Do not shake the device. Avoid brute force when installing or operating the device.
- Do not switch the device on and off in short intervals, as this would reduce the system's life.
- Do not touch the device's housing bare-handed during its operation (housing becomes very hot).
- Only use device indoor, avoid contact with water or other liquids.
- Only operate the fixture after having checked that the housing is firmly closed and all screws are tightly fastened.
- Only operate the device after having familiarized with its functions.
- Avoid flames and do not put close to flammable liquids orgases.
- · Always replace the lamp, when it is damaged or deformed due to the heat.
- Always keep case closed while operating.
- Always allow free airspace of at least 50 cm around the unit for ventilation.
- Always disconnect power from the mains, when device is not used or before cleaning! Only handle the power cord by the plug. Never pull out the plug by tugging the power cord.
- Make sure that the device is not exposed to extreme heat, moisture or dust.
- Make sure that the available voltage is not higher than stated on the rearpanel.
- Make sure that the powercord is never crimped or damaged. Check the device and the power cord from time to time.
- The cable insert or the female part in the device must never be strained. There must always be sufficient cable to the device. Otherwise, the cable may be damaged which may lead to deadly electrical shocks.
- If one of the lamps is obviously damaged, it has to be replaced. So that its functions are not impaired, due to cracks or deep scratches.
- If the external cable is damaged, it has to be replaced by a qualified technic ian.
- If device is dropped or struck, disconnect mains power supply immediately. Have a qualified engineer inspect for safety before operating.
- If the device has been exposed to drastic temperature fluctuation (e.g. after transportation), do not switch it on immediately. The arising condensation water might damage your device. Leave the device switched off until it has reached room temperature.
- If your Showtec device fails to work properly, discontinue use immediately. Pack the unit securely (preferably in the original packing material), and return it to your Showtec dealer for service.
- For a dult use only. The device must be installed out of the reach of children. Never leave the unit running unattended.
- The user is responsible for correct positioning and operating of the Stage Blinder 2. The manufacturer will not accept liability for damages caused by the misuse or incorrect installation of this device.
- This device falls under protection class I. Therefore it is essential to connect the yellow/green conductor to earth.
- For replacement use lamps and fuses of same type and rating only.
- Allow time to cooldown, before replacing lamp.
- · Repairs, servicing and electric connection must be carried out by a qualified technician.

# Operating Determinations

- This device is not designed for permanent operation. Consistent operation breaks will ensure that the device will serve you for a long time without defects.
- The minimum distance between light output and the illuminated surface must be bigger than 1 meter.
- The maximum ambient temperature  $t_a = 40^{\circ}$ C must never be exceeded.
- The relative humidity must not exceed 50 % with an ambient temperature of 40° C.
- If this device is operated in any other way than the one described in this manual, the product may suffer damages and the warranty becomes void.
- Any other operation may lead to dangers like short-circuit, burns, electric shock, crash, etc.

# Rig g ing

Please follow the European and national guidelines concerning rigging, trussing and all othersafety issues.


Do not attempt the installation yourself!

Always let the installation be carried out by an authorized dealer!

#### Procedure:

- If the projector is lowered from the ceiling or high joists, professional trussing systems have to be used.
- Use a clamp to mount the projector, with the mounting bracket, to the trussing system.
- The projector must never be fixed swinging freely in the room.
- The installation must always be secured with a safety attachment, e.g. an appropriate safety net or safety cable.
- When rigging, derigging or servicing the projector, always make sure, that the area below the installation site is secured and that there are not any unauthorized people around.





The Stage Blindercan be placed on a flat stage floorormounted to any kind of truss with a clamp.

Improper installation can cause serious injuries and/ordamage of property!

# Return Procedure

Be prepared to provide the model number, serial number and a brief description of the cause for the return. Be sure to properly pack fixture, any shipping damage resulting from inadequate packaging is the customer's responsibility. Highlite reserves the right to use its own discretion to repair or replace product(s). As a suggestion, proper UPS packing or double-boxing is always a safe method to use.

#### Claims





# Installation

Remove all packing materials from the Stage Blinder 2 DMX. Check if all foam and plastic padding is removed. Connect all cables.

Do not supply power before the whole system is set up and connected properly.

Always disconnect from electric mains power supply before cleaning or servicing.

Damages caused by non-observance are not subject to warranty.



# Installing the Lamp

The Stage Blinder 2 DMX uses the GEPar 36 G53 Screw MFL 120V 650W (order ode 80117) bulb as manufactured by all popular manufacturers. Use only the appropriate lamp for your unit.

Note, that product versions that use other lamps, may be offered in the future. Check your product specification label for information.

## Always disconnect from electric mains power supply before changing lamps.

The lamp has to be replaced when it is damaged or deformed due to the heat.

**Do not install lamps with a higher wattage!** Lamps with a higher wattage generate temperatures the device was not designed for.

Damages caused by non-observance are not subject to warranty.

#### Procedure

- 01) Loosen the 2 screws on the front of the lamp housing.
- 02) Gently remove the metallamp housing.
- 03) Allow 15 minutes for the lamp to cool down.
- 04) Read lamp instructions. Do not touch the lamp bulb glass. Gently remove the lamp from its socket.
- 05) Unscrew the 2 wires on the backside of the lamp and remove the lamp. Oil on hands shortens the lamp life. (If you touch the bulb glass, wipe off the glass with a clean, lint-free towel and rubbing a lcohol)
- 06) Take the new lamp out of the carton box.
- 07) Take the 2 cables and tighten the screws on the back of the lamp. Place the lamp in the socket.
- 08) Put the metallamp housing back and fasten the 2 screws snugly.



# Set Up and Operation

Follow the directions below, as they pertain to your preferred operation mode.

Before plugging the unit in, always make sure that the power supply matches the product specific ation voltage. Do not attempt to operate a 120V specific ation product on 230V power, or vice versa. Connect the device to the main power supply.


#### Control Modes

There are 2 modes:

- Stand-alone (Auto)
- DMX-512 (1CH)

#### One Stage Blinder (Stand-alone)


- 01) Fasten the effect light onto firm trussing. Leave at least 0,5 meter on all sides for airc irc ulation.
- 02) Always use a safety cable (order ode 70140 / 70141).
- 03) Plug the end of the electric mains power cord into a proper electric power supply socket.
- 04) When the Stage Blinder is not connected with a DMX-cable, it functions as a stand-alone device. Dip switch #10 must always be set to ON for Stand-alone control.




Stand-alone: Dip switch # 10 to ON position.

#### Multiple Stage Blinders (DMX control)

- 01) Fasten the effect light onto firm trussing. Leave at least 0,5 meteron all sides for airc irc ulation.
- 02) Always use a safety cable (order ode 70140 / 70141).
- 03) Use a 3-pin XIR cable to connect the Stage Blinders and other devices.



**DMX control:** Dip switch # 10 to OFF position. Move dip switches # 1-9 to set the desired DMX address. Red IED on the backside of the device is blinking.



- 01) Link the units as shown in fig. 04. Connect the first unit's DMX "out" socket with the second unit's "in" socket, using a DMX-signalcable. Repeat this process to link the second, third, and fourth units.
- 02) Supply electric power. Plug the power cords into proper electric power supply sockets, starting with the first unit. Do not supply power before the whole system is set up and connected properly.



# Multiple Stage Blinders DMX Set Up



Note: Link all cables and set dip switches before connecting electric power

After switching on, the Stage Blinder will automatically detect whether DMX 512 data is received or not.

If there is no data received, the problem may be:

- 01) The XIR cable from the controller is not connected with the input of the Stage Blinder.
- 02) The controller is switched off or defective, the cable or connector is detective, or the signal wires are swapped in the input connector.

Note: It is necessary to insert a XIR termination plug (with 120 Ohm) in the last fixture in order to ensure proper transmission on the DMX data link.



# Dip switch setting for DMX mode

DMX products must have their own address to receive DMX signals. Addresses on the controller are set by flipping the appropriate dip switches # 1-9.

DMX address settings are the sum of the dip switch values. A standard DMX address for the Showtec Stage Blinder is as follows:

## Example 1

Explanation: Since each unit has 1 channel, each address advances by 1 value (See Address Value above). Once address values are determined, add DMX dip switch values to obtain the appropriate address (DMX Dip Switches "ON") for each unit. Flip appropriate DMX dip switches on each unit.

# Example 2

- 01) If you want to give a Stage Blinder DMX address 133, you first have to find the number 133 in the DMX Chart. (See page 13)
- 02) Look at the left side (Dip Switches #1-#5) ho rizo ntally from 133. In the table you'll see #1=0N, #2=0FF, #3=0N, #4=0FF, #5=0FF.
- 03) Finally look at the upper side of the table (Dip Switches #6-#9) vertically from 133. In the table you'll see #6=OFF, #7=OFF, #8=ON, #9=OFF.

# Fixture Linking

You will need a serial data link to run light shows of one ormore fixtures using a DMX-512 controller or to run synchronized shows of two ormore fixtures set to a master slave operating mode. The combined number of channels required by all the fixtures on a serial data link determines the number of fixtures the data link can support.

Important:

Fixture son a serial data link must be daisy-chained in a single line. To comply with the EIA-485 standard, no more than 30 devices should be connected on one data link. Connecting more than 30 fixtures on one serial data link without the use of a DMX optically isolated splitter may result in deterioration of the digital DMX signal.



Maximum recommended DMX data link distance: 100 meters

Maximum recommended number of fixtures on a DMX data link: 30 fixtures

# Data Cabling

To link fixtures to gether, you must obtain data cables. You can purchase DAP Audio certified DMX cables directly from a dealer distributor or construct your own cable. If you choose to create your own cable, please use data-grade cables that can carry a high quality signal and are less prone to electromagnetic interference.

# Mainte nance

The operator has to make sure that safe ty-relating and machine-technical installations are to be inspected by an expert after every year in the course of an acceptance test.

The operator has to make sure that safety-related and machine-technical installations are to be inspected by a skilled person once a year.

The following points have to be considered during the inspection:

- 01) All screws used for installing the device or parts of the device have to be tightly connected and must not be corroded.
- 02) There may not be any deformations on housings, fixations and installation spots.
- 03) Mechanically moving parts like axles, eyes and others may not show any traces of wearing.
- 04) The electric power supply cables must not show any damages or material fatigue.

The Showtec Stage Blinder 2 requires a lmost no maintenance. However, you should keep the unit clean. Otherwise, the fixture's light output will be significantly reduced. Disconnect the mains power supply, and then wipe the cover with a damp cloth. Do not immerse in liquid. Wipe lamps clean with glass cleaner and a soft cloth. Do not use alcoholor solvents.

The lamps will require weekly cleaning, as smoke-fluid tends to build up residues, reducing the light-output very quickly.

Keep connections clean. Disconnect electric power, and then wipe the DMX and audio connections with a damp cloth. Make sure connections are thoroughly dry before linking equipment or supplying electric power.

# Changing the Lamp

- 01) Disconnect mains power supply, and allow 15 minutes to cool down.
- 02) Loosen the knurled bolt on the back of the lamp housing and pull the housing out.
- 03) Holding it by the base, remove the lamp from its retention box.
- 04) Follow directions for installing a new lamp, page 9.

# Trouble shooting

This trouble shooting guide is meant to help solve simple problems.

If a problem occurs, carry out the steps below in sequence until a solution is found. Once the unit operates properly, do not carry out following steps.

#### No Light

If the light effect does not operate properly, refer servicing to a technician.

Suspect three potential problem areas as: the power supply, the lamp, the fuse.

- 01) Power supply. Check that the unit is plugged into an appropriate power supply.
- 02) The lamp. Replace the lamp. See page 9 for installing the lamp.
- 03) The fuse. Return the device to your Showtec dealer.
- 04) If all of the above appears to be O.K, plug the unit in again.
- 05) If you are unable to determine the cause of the problem, do not open the Stage Blinder, as this may damage the unit and the warranty will become void.
- 06) Return the device to your Showtec dealer.

- 01) Check the DMX setting. Make sure that DMX addresses are correct.
- 02) Check the DMX cable: Unplug the unit; change the DMX cable; then reconnect to electrical power. Try your DMX control again.
- 03) Determine whether the controller or light effect is at fault. Does the controller operate properly with other DMX products? If not, take the controller in for repair. If so, take the DMX cable and the light effect to a qualified technic ian.
